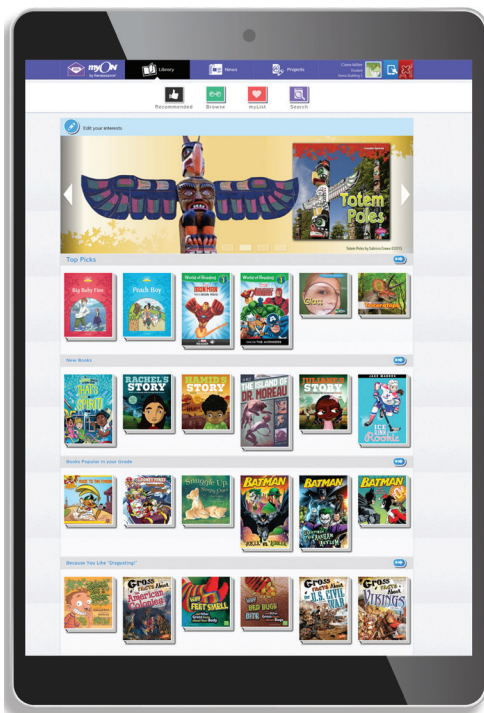


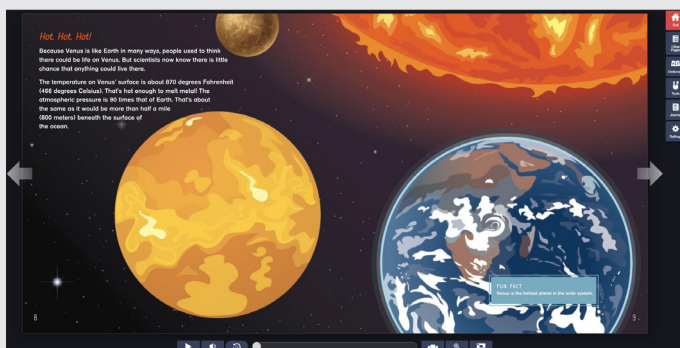

Aggregated engagement metrics will be available, including total number of books and articles students have read and the amount of time they have spent reading, as well as indicators of reading habits including when students are reading with myON.

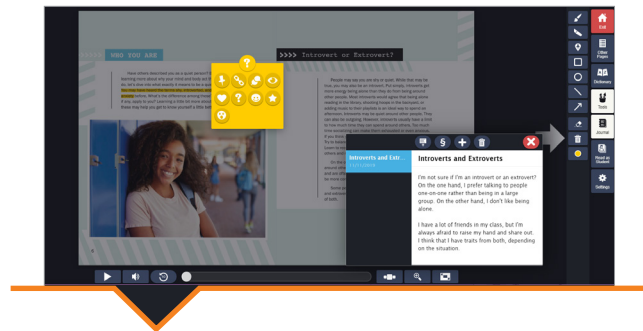
While students are engaged in summer reading, schools are looking ahead to the new instructional cycle. Scheduling uncertainties mean that remote learning is sure to be part of the planning process.
