

BHS Exemption Policy

Exemptions

To establish an incentive yet maintain student academic preparation for future educational experiences, Brownwood High School offers an exemption plan designed to stimulate students to put forth their very best academic efforts.

First Semester – all students (9th – 12th) will take their Math and English Exam

Second Semester – all students (9th – 12th) will take their Science and History Exam

Who May Be Exempt

Students in the 9th-12th grade may be exempt in core classes (English, Math, Science & History) if they meet the following grade criteria:

- 88 and Above Semester Average

Students in the 9th-12th grade may be exempt in elective classes if they meet the following grade criteria:

- 80 and Above Semester Average

Discipline criteria:

- DAEP Placement – lose exemptions in all classes for Semester receiving DAEP
- Suspension – lose exemptions in all classes for Semester receiving OSS
- ISS Placement – lose exemptions in all classes for Semester receiving ISS

Remote and homebound students are ineligible for exemptions.

Exemption Ineligibility

The principal may declare a student ineligible for exemption in all subjects for flagrant violation of school policies such as truancy or improper conduct in and around school or school activities.

State Assessments
