

## Students Who Entered Grade 9 in the 2018–19 School Year and Thereafter

For students who entered grade 9 in the 2018–19 school year and thereafter, the District shall include in the calculation of class rank semester grades earned in high school credit courses taken in the following subject areas only: English, mathematics, science, and social studies.

The calculation shall include failing grades. If a student retakes the course for credit, only the original grade shall be included in the calculation.

The calculation of class rank shall exclude grades earned in an assigned remediation or tutoring course, or credit by examination, with or without prior instruction.

The District shall categorize and weight eligible courses as AP/Dual Credit/Dual Enrollment, Pre-AP, and Regular in accordance with provisions of this policy. Courses receiving weighted grade points shall be designated in the student course catalog.

The District shall convert grades earned in eligible courses to grades points and shall calculate a weighted GPA in accordance with the following chart:
