*\* To apply for Pre-K, the child must be 3 or 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2023.*

*\*\*Currently enrolled 3-year-olds must requalify for the new school year.*

*To be eligible for Pre-K, the child must meet at least one of the following criteria:*

1. The child qualifies for the BISD English as a Second Language Program (assessment administered by district staff);
2. The child has ever been in the care of DFPS (form 2085 required);
3. The family has lost housing due to economic hardship;
4. The child is a military dependent (Department of Defense ID or Statement of Service required);
5. The child qualifies for Medicaid, TANF, or SNAP benefits (EDG letter required); or
6. The family meets income guidelines based on number of people in the household. Acceptable documentation includes:
  - a. Pay stubs for all wage-earners in the household for the previous month, or
  - b. Income tax returns for 2022.
7. Brownwood ISD employees' children automatically qualify, but they **MUST** be approved and pre-registered on April 4 or 5 for space and staffing determination.
