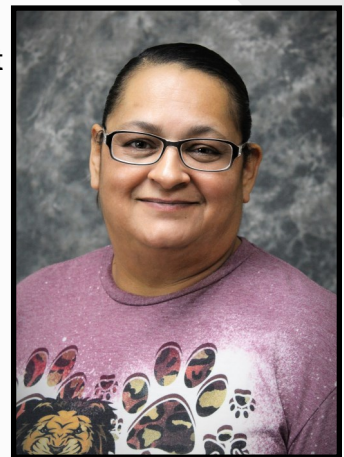
brings with Ms. Smith as a part of Team Woodland Heights!
