- TPSP objectives, lessons, and rubrics are considered in the development of lessons and activities building up to major projects
- Clustered in classrooms with other GT students
- Students receive differentiated instruction

First Grade - Third Grade (East, Northwest, and Woodland Heights)

- Clustered in classrooms with other GT students
- Students receive differentiated instruction

Fourth Grade- Sixth Grade (Coggin Intermediate School)

- Pull-out program during enrichment; 1 1/2 hours per week
