To apply for transfer to a school other than the zoned Neighborhood School, parents must provide the information below in addition to student demographics.

- School attended in Brownwood ISD during 21-22
- NEW Neighborhood School Attendance Zone according to home address
- School requested for 22-23
- Detailed reason for request to transfer to a school other than the neighborhood school, or to remain at original campus
- New Pre-K and Kindergarten students must qualify and pre-register before applying for transfer
